Allied Arts Council Scholarship Showcase 2020

Competition Performance: Wednesday, April 15, 2020

An important goal for the Allied Arts Council of Lake Havasu City is to promote the Arts to our community's youth and encourage them to develop their art talents. AAC has created an annual scholarship program that awards talented youth with money to help them fund more instruction through a university, community college, workshop or private teacher.

Students interested in applying for a scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Be at least 16 years of age by the end of 2020.
2. Complete and return the written application by Tuesday, March 31, 2020, including a letter of recommendation from a current or past instructor in the student's art genre.
3. Compete on Wednesday April 15 at the assigned time.

Students will introduce themselves and share how they will use their scholarship, if awarded, to develop their talent.

Performing artists then introduce what they will present, including acknowledging the composer, writer, or choreographer, before performing a polished 3 to 5 minute selection in either dance, music (instrumental or vocal), or theater(drama, comedy, monologues). Accompaniment may be live or recorded. Though not required, costume, make-up, and simple props are strongly encouraged to embellish the overall look of your presentation. Visual artists need to present 4 to 5 pieces of 2D or 3D art in the medium of their choice (i.e. drawing, painting, sculpture, etc) and discuss their artwork with judges.

4. Have a realistic plan for using the money, within six months of receiving the check, to further their skills in the art genre in which they are competing. Award money may be used toward lessons, workshops or tuition at a two or four-year school where the major or minor is the area in which the student competed.

The competition will be held this year on April 15, 2020 beginning at 3:30 pm at the Performing Arts Center at the Lake Havasu High School campus located at 2675 S. Palo Verde Blvd. Applicants will be notified by email as to what time they are scheduled to compete. All applicants must be on time and ready to begin their performance immediately at their given time. A panel of judges will score applicants on their performance or art work. A photo will be taken of each applicant, and winner's photos and names will be released to the Today News Herald and also appear in the next Allied Arts Council Spotlight on the Arts.

Following the competition the Scholarship Committee will tally the scores to determine the winners. Winners will receive checks by mail. Scholarship checks will be made out to both the student and the school/instructor where the continuing education will take place. All students will also be given a copy of the judges' comments, which they can use to assist them to prepare for future competitions.
